

RACE AND RACISM IN CINCINNATI: A 3-PART DOCUSERIES

Thank you for your interest in Race and Racism in Cincinnati: A 3 Part Docuseries. Provided here is an outline of the films, what we offer in conjunction with the films, and the cost.

FILM DESCRIPTIONS:

Race and Racism in Cincinnati: Part One – 45 minutes

Cincinnati's Founding: The Experience of Native Americans and Black People in Cincinnati, 1787 - 1863

This video chronicles the founding of Cincinnati by first acknowledging from whom the land was stolen. We then journey through important sites across Cincinnati that commemorate places of resilience and learn about black life during that time period. After this video, participants will have a better knowledge of Cincinnati's connection to slavery and involvement in the Civil War.

Race and Racism in Cincinnati: Part Two - 66 minutes

Education and Housing Disparities - Post Civil War - 1950s

In the second video, we enter the post-slavery era of Cincinnati. Participants will learn about the radical act of Black education and hear stories of resilience. This video challenges our conceptions of diversity and what true desegregation means. Participants will learn about the impact of redlining and highway creation on the blooming suburbs that led to heavily segregated neighborhoods.

Race and Racism in Cincinnati: Part Three - 75 minutes

The Movements for Justice and the Legacy of Funk, 1950s - Now

In our final video, we grapple with the issues our city faces today, including police violence and gentrification. Participants will learn about the early integrated King Records and how Cincinnati was connected to the Civil Rights Movement. Part three explores what true safety looks like and asks what we think communities need to thrive.
